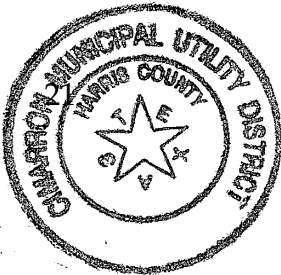
CIMARRON MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT

The Board of Directors of Cimarron Municipal Utility District will hold a regular meeting on Wednesday, April 15, 2026, at 12:00 p.m., at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2400, San Jacinto Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Receive public comments.
2. Approve Minutes.
3. Security Matters.
4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments.
5. Terminate Municipal Advisory Services Agreement with Robert W. Baird & Co. Incorporated and engage Cedar Creek Municipal Advisors, LLC as the District's Financial Advisor.
6. Review Arbitrage Rebate Report for the Series 2021 Refunding Bonds.
7. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
8. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for construction projects, if any;
 - b. review bids and award contract for construction projects, if any;
 - c. pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance of facilities, if any;
 - d. utility commitment letters;
 - e. deeds, easements, and encroachments; and
 - f. report regarding development in the District.
9. Landscaping and trail reports, including approval of pay estimates, change orders, proposals for maintenance of landscaping and irrigation, and sidewalk construction.
10. Pond maintenance and mowing report.
11. Phase II Small MS4 General Permit and Storm Water Management Program including status of compliance, necessary training, and public comment.
12. Operation of District facilities, including billings, repairs, maintenance, and utility bill messages and amend Rate Order, if necessary.
13. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
14. Conduct annual review and receive report from operator on Identity Theft Prevention Program and adopt Identity Theft Prevention Program Amendment.
